## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR REBUILD ALABAMA

WHEREAS, the Town of Rehobeth will receive approximately \$24,000 in Rebuild Alabama Funds in Fiscal Year 2024 and must adopt an annual plan detailing how and where the funds will be utilized, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Rehobeth, Alabama utilized the funds allocated for the 2023 year to pave National Rd in joint project with Houston County, Alabama, and will save 2024 funds to be allocated for future paving and road improvement projects.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REHOBETH, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON AUGUST 15, 2023, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Town Council of the Town of Rehobeth hereby adopts this Resolution as its Transportation Plan submitted in compliance with the Rebuild Alabama Act, No. 2019-2.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to continue to keep these funds separate and receipt and deposit funds received pursuant to the Act, the proceeds of which shall be expended solely for the maintenance improvement replacement and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the Town and such other uses as are authorized by the Act.
